



Welcome! SAT Prep is two-part course designed to prepare you for your college admission exams. There will be a strong emphasis on the Critical Reading aspect of the test because that is the primary verbal area that every school currently uses for admission criteria along with the math section.

This is a 45-day course. During the other half of the semester, you will take the math portion of the course with Mrs. Runco.

Required Materials

Bring the following to class each day: pencil, notebook, folder, and all handouts

Assignments, Tests, and Assessments

Because this is a class about a test, most class work and homework will be graded on the attempt to do the work with exceptional effort. Homework and class work are generally 10-20 points per assignment.

The following will have more stringent grading levels:

Busted – Response to SAT vocabulary book – 100 pts

Word Root Project – 50 points

Literary Term Power point – 50 points

Final Literary Term Test – 100 points

Critical Reading Final Test – 100 points
